Parking: Do not park in the visitor parking lot or pay the parking fee. We will park our cars inside the gated area to avoid congesting the visitor parking lot.

Wear work clothes with an Egwa t-shirt. Bring work gloves, water, sack lunch and rain gear. (We will work rain or shine unless the Rangers decide we are doing more harm than good.)

All participants will need to complete the Volunteer Services Agreement for Natural Resources Agencies available on the Lodge website and bring it to the Day of Service. If you are under 18 years old make sure and have it signed by a parent/guardian. Also bring a copy of your current BSA Annual Health and Medical Record.
